

Designated First Aid Points are located at The Knoll and the Boating Lake. First aid bikes will be travelling with the parade and an ambulance will be positioned at the rear. If you are unable to see a first aider, please alert the nearest marshal who is aware of the procedure for alerting help.

#### **Lost Children and Vulnerable Persons**

In the unlikely event of this happening, the Lost Child or Vulnerable Person Point is located at the Resort Hub/Beach Safety, opposite the Pier, DN35 8YA. It will be manned until 6pm, after which the Point will be reverted to The Knoll.

#### **Toilets**

Public toilets are available at Grant Street, St Peter's Avenue, Pier Gardens, Knoll car park, Lower Kingsway and the Boating Lake. We suggest not using toilets in local cafes, pubs etc unless absolutely necessary. However, it will be the decision of local businesses, if they will allow the use of their toilets.

#### Litter

We ask all visitors to dispose of litter responsibly and use the bins provided. The bins can very quickly become full and access to empty them can be tricky at busy times. If the bins are full, please leave your litter as close to the bin as possible. We are a very small team and it is our responsibility to ensure the route is kept clean. A big Thank You to Andy's Man Club, who have volunteered to litter pick during and after the parade on Friday.
